What is Grad Slam?

Grad Slam is an award-winning campus-wide competition that showcases top graduate students and their research. Students present their research in action-packed three-minute talks to a diverse audience comprised of students, faculty, and community members. The stakes are high with over \$20,000 in prize money on the line.

Why is it Important?

Delivering engaging talks that captivate the audience is an essential skill that our graduate students must master if they want to spread their research findings beyond the lab or academic journal. The Grad Slam competition is the culmination of a professional development series that focuses on key public speaking skills such as content development, stage presence, visual elements, and adapting to different audiences.

New Format This Year!

Ten discipline champions from across campus will come together to compete for the overall UCSB crown. UCSB's 70+ graduate degree programs will be broken up into eight categories with separate preliminary Grad Slam competitions to be held. These categories include humanities and fine arts, social sciences, education, earth & biological sciences, math & brain sciences, chemistry & physics, environmental management, and engineering. Each of the preliminary Grad Slam competitions will provide cash prizes for the winner and runner-up.

The 2024 Grad Slam Finals competition will be held on April 5, 2024.
